



PRIVACY POLICY OF THE "CANDIA TECHNOLOGY.IT" WEB SITE

These pages describe how to manage the site in relation to the processing of personal data of users and visitors. This is an information note also pursuant to art. 13 of Legislative Decree no. 196/2003 (Code regarding the protection of personal data) to those who interact with the web services of the company Candia Technology srl, accessible by telematic means at the address: www.candiatechnology.it. The information is also based on the Recommendation n. 2/2001 that the European authorities for the protection of personal data, gathered in the Group established by art. 29 of the directive n. 95/46 / EC, adopted on 17 May 2001 to identify some minimum requirements for the collection of personal data online and, in particular, the methods, timing and nature of the information that the data controllers must provide to users when these connect to web pages, regardless of the purpose of the link.

Owner of data processing

Following consultation of this site, data relating to identified or identifiable persons may be processed: the holder of their processing is the company Candia Technology srl, with registered office in Sona (Vr), via Liguria n.16. (Italy)

Place of data processing and purpose of processing of the themselves

The treatments connected to the web services of this site are handled only by authorized personnel or by persons who may be in charge of occasional maintenance operations. These take place at the premises of the undersigned company and at the premises of the following subjects, technology providers:

No data acquired via the web service is diffused.

The personal data provided by users who forward requests and / or communications by e-mail are, however, used only to perform the service or provision requested, and are communicated to third parties only if necessary in relation to this purpose.

Types of data processed

A) Browsing data

The computer systems and software procedures used to operate this website acquire, during their normal operation, some personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols.

This is information that is not collected to be associated with identified interested parties, but which by their very nature could, through processing and association with data held by third parties, allow users to be identified.

This category of data includes IP addresses or domain names of the computers used by users connecting to the site, the addresses in the Uniform Resource Identifier (URI) notation of the requested

resources, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the response given by the server (success, error, etc.) and other parameters relating to the operating system and the user's computer.

These data are used, at most, for the sole purpose of obtaining anonymous statistical information on the use of the site and to check its correct functioning. The data could be used to ascertain responsibility in case of hypothetical computer crimes against the site.

B) Data provided voluntarily by the user

The optional, explicit and voluntary sending of e-mails to the addresses indicated on this site entails the subsequent acquisition of the sender's address, which is essential to respond to requests, as well as any other personal data included in the message.

Failure to provide them, even partially, may make it impossible to obtain what has been requested.

Mode of data processing

Personal data are processed by computer and / or telematic tools for the time strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were collected. Specific security measures are observed to prevent data loss, illicit or incorrect use and unauthorized access.

Rights of the interested parties

Eventually we inform you that Legislative Decree no. 196/03 gives the interested party the exercise of specific rights. In particular, the interested party can obtain from the holder confirmation of the existence, or not, of their personal data and that such data will be communicated to him in an intelligible form.

The interested party, also, has the right to obtain an indication of the origin of personal data, of the purposes and methods of processing, of the logic applied in case of processing with the help of electronic means, of the identification details of the holder and the managers and the subjects or categories of subjects to whom the personal data may be communicated or who may become aware of it.

The interested party also has the right to obtain the updating, rectification or, if there is interest, the integration of data, cancellation, transformation into anonymous form or blocking of data processed in violation of the discipline as well as 'attestation that these operations have been brought to the attention of those to whom the data have been communicated or disseminated. Finally, the interested party has the right to object, for legitimate reasons, to the processing of data concerning him / her and to the processing of personal data concerning him / her for the purpose of sending advertising material or direct selling or for carrying out research on market or commercial communication.
